


How to Ride MCT To School

PLAN YOUR ROUTE



Using Google Maps, enter the starting point and destination of your trip. Select the transit icon  and the date and time of your desired arrival. Google Maps will give detailed instructions based on the nearest bus stop, when the bus picks up, transfers to any other bus routes, and drop-off location and time.

BOARD THE BUS



Arrive at the bus stop a few minutes before the scheduled arrival time and wait by the stop keeping an eye out for the bus. Upon boarding, let the driver know where you're going to ensure you're boarding the correct route.

PAY YOUR FARE




For the month of September, GCSD students ride MCT buses for free. Simply show the driver your school ID or school district issued Chromebook. Make sure you have this ready to show the driver as the bus arrives.

HAVE A SEAT



Sit down in an open seat. Place any personal items in your lap or under your seat so they are out of the aisles. Be mindful of other riders around you. No loud music, eating, or drinking is allowed on the bus.

PULL THE CORD



About a block before your stop pull the cord that hangs along the window. When the cord is pulled you will hear the announcement "Stop Requested." This will alert the driver you'd like to get off at the next stop. Make sure the bus has come to a complete stop before standing to exit the bus.

If you are unsure where to get off or when to pull the cord, let the driver know where you're going. Our drivers will be happy to help you on your way to school!

If you have any questions at all while traveling, please ask our drivers - they are happy to help!
