MCT PROVIDES FREE SHUTTLE SERVICE TO ENJOY IL 300

Offering Convenient Transportation from Collinsville's Gateway Convention Center

PONTOON BEACH, IL, AUGUST 22, 2025... Madison County Transit (MCT) will once again provide complimentary shuttle service to the Enjoy IL 300 NASCAR Cup Playoff Race at World Wide Technology Raceway on Sunday, September 7, 2025.

Free shuttles will operate from the Gateway Convention Center Park & Ride Lot (60 Gateway Drive, Collinsville) directly to and from the raceway. Service begins at 8:00 AM, with the last bus leaving the raceway at 9:00 PM. This convenient option allows race fans to avoid traffic congestion and parking challenges on race day.

The Enjoy IL 300 has quickly become one of the region's premier sporting events, drawing nearly 100,000 fans from across the country. With such large crowds expected, MCT's shuttle service offers attendees a safe, efficient, and stress-free way to get to the race.
